Hall of Fame – Criteria

When looking for suitable candidates to be inducted into the EDPL Hall of Fame it is recommended that the following areas be considered. The inductees may fall within one or even several areas listed.

- ❖ People involved in the development of the league – helping to build and provide innovative direction
- ❖ People involved in the history of the League – those involved in the original concepts and development – the founding members
- ❖ Those involved in the administration of the League – people that have become Life Members through dedication to the Executive Committee – members that have carried a heavy workload within the Executive
- ❖ Members that have volunteered and provided either practical or administrative support without actually being members of the Executive
- ❖ Outstanding and or continued achievements within the sport – over 700 games played – representing our League in Interleague, Victorian or Australian teams – finishing on several occasions in the top twelve players of their division
- ❖ People who have provided continued and or outstanding service to their club – holding an executive position for many years – being a team Captain for many years – leading a team to a Premiership on several occasions (not necessarily the same team)
- ❖ Any worthy service to the EDPL

It is important to remember to look at the overall character of candidates and service to the Eastern District Pool League. The above criteria are broad so as not to be limit the individuals chosen to be inducted.

The final decision is that of the current EDPL Hall of Fame Committee.
